Loans for the Recognition of Foreign Credentials (PRTCE)

A Program Funded by the Quebec Government to Facilitate Integration

With the support of the Ministry of Employment and Social Solidarity and in partnership with the Caisse d'économie solidaire Desjardins, we offer this loan program to immigrants to help them have their experience and diplomas recognized by the 46 professional orders. Our program facilitates and accelerates the integration of these individuals into the economy and more broadly, into Quebec society. Loans range from \$500 to \$15,000 and can be repaid over three years.

Thanks to our internal loan program, an initiative specifically set up to support immigrant professionals who cannot benefit from the PRTCE program, we have been able to financially support five individuals in their professional journey. A total of \$30,000 in loans has been granted.
